HENRY, a miner, and ELIZABETH NEALE with two sons arrived at Moreton Bay on the Artemesia 13 Dec 1848. Henry's obituary in the Darling Downs Gazette indicates that Henry and Elizabeth were first offered work by Pitts and Bonnifant, the owners of Goombungee Station, journeying there by bullock wagon. Twelve months later a better opening presented itself with Mr Mallard of Felton Station. After two years they were induced to try their luck on the goldfield at Summerhill Creek near Bathurst but soon returned to the Downs in the employment of J. D. McLean of Westbrook Station. Six years with the mounted police followed, stationed in Drayton, before Henry settled on a small farm he had purchased near Drayton. He used his dray and horses as a subcontractor on the railway but, due to the government's financial crisis, it was a long time before he was paid for his work. From 1868 to 1870 or 1872, Henry was the lessee of the Bulls Head Inn. Henry was a Councillor and later Mayor of Drayton. He was appointed a trustee of the Drayton Town Commonage in 1875. Newspaper obituaries indicate Henry and Elizabeth had a total of twenty-one children.
