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FOREWORD HYDE OF HAMILTON

The time-honoured method of presenting the genealogical details of a family was by a "tree". This, later varied by tracing descent downwards, using lines which being similar in form to a crane's foot, gave the term "pedigree" (from the French). Your editors hope that the numerical system here used will be clear. It sprang from the notion of saving space!

The within account of the branch of the Hyde family which emigrated to South Australia in the "provincial" first five years (1836-1841) does not pretend to have any clear account of the forebears of our common ancestors, John and Ann Jane. We do know that they came from Country Armagh. The little badge which we believe does belong to the family, derives from an esquire to the Earl of Shannon (also named John Hyde). As, however, registration of births by the civic authority in Ireland only began in 1865, it is felt that, in the interests of authenticity, it is reasonable to start with our own pioneers. From 1839 onwards your editors have found ample confirmation of the details we have set down. There are a few gaps in the family details indeed, due to reluctance on the part of some members to have matters set down, or else that we have failed to cast our net wide enough.

As may be seen from the lists, the name of "Hyde" does not figure largely in them. All who trace descent from these Irish ancestors are, or should be, included. This has meant that over eighty surnames appear in the family. Two branches live in Western Australia; others are in the Eastern States, except that, as far as we know, none are in Tasmania. It is believed a few went to the United States of America. A few are in New Zealand. No-one of the Hyde surname remains in Hamilton, though the present farmer at Hydedale does include his mother's maiden name with his father's surname.

Most of the direct descendants have been given their full names, at least in the "family" listings. Of those who joined the descendants by marriage, one personal name is usually entered. Those who have supplied details have our grateful thanks. To those whose names have been entered without specific permission, we offer apology, and trust that we may be forgiven. Perhaps the editors may keep "master copies" to which they can add further names and details as supplied. In this connection we are aware that this is dated to 1973, and the centre spread was set out in September of that year.

There are, within this State, a large number of family trees being drawn up. The State Archives Department, on North Terrace, is anxious to have copies. There is also a Genealogical Society which offers advice and assistance. Your editors have studied some of these "trees", but have in the layout, struck a line of their own. In order to fit the centre spread, the setting out had to start with the long list of the fifth generation, that being the most difficult to fit into one table. There will, we expect, be further additions to that generation, as well as in the later generation.

We have no picture of the pioneer JOHN, who died before photography became common. Nor do we include a copy of the ticket on the "Ariadne" — supposed in some trees to give assurance that the pioneer ancestors were not convict. The illustrations in the text are felt to give a little sentimental spice to the story of the descendants of HYDE OF HAMILTON.

We, therefore, launch our effort, incompleted though it necessarily is, with the hope that it will be acceptable to the "family", and with thanks to those who have helped us.

OF THE HYDES OF HAMILTON

His name was plain JOHN HYDE, and he came from Ireland to South Australia in 1839. With him were his wife and four children.

PIONEER STATUS. For the first five years of South Australia, under Governors Hindmarsh and Gawler, the "State" was a "PROVINCE", not a colony. The romantic Parliament of the thirties of last century even passed a special act to set it up, permitted a Company to sell a thousand acre blocks in advance, and arranged three separate authorities to implement the scheme. In those five years the Province slowly slid into bankruptcy, rescued by George Gray (1841-5). In his early years immigration virtually ceased, making the division between the "pioneers" and those who came to enjoy the copper prosperity of the later fifth decade.

JOHN HYDE: ANN JANE (nee Whitley). These two were married in County Armagh about the time of Daniel O'Connell's great triumph in 1829. In those years there was wholesale emigration, mostly to U.S.A. John and his wife, in ten years of marriage had acquired four children, with whom, in the summer of 1839, they set sail for Greenock. The "Ariadne" took them to Port Adelaide in the Australian spring. (On board with them was another Hyde, by name George, who stayed for a time in the State). John and his family made their way south, only to have trouble crossing the Onkaparinga, where they lost most of their possessions. After this inauspicious start, John was attracted by the accounts of the Para and Light Rivers, consequent on Colonel Light's visit to those parts a few months earlier. And so to HAMILTON, the whole six of them.

John lived long enough for his eldest son to take over. Conditions in the State improved, especially in the Kapunda (copper) area. John was only fifty-two when he died. Ann Jane lived on for a further thirty-nine years, by which time her descendants numbered nearly fifty. (1792-1891)

ROBERT (1). On the father's death, on Christmas Day 1851, Robert was in his twenty-second year. He stayed in Hamilton for some further thirteen years, during which time he married (1855) Elizabeth Cropley. Four children were born at the old Hyde homestead, the last of whom, named after her grandmother, died in infancy. Country memories are long, and Robert and his Elizabeth are still remembered in the South Kilkerran district where they settled for some years from 1865. (That was the year of the Moonta copper boom). Their fifth child was born there, but died after two months. In the following ten years there were four more children, two of each sex. The girls, Elizabeth (17) and Adelaide (19) established families. Of the former, (Mrs. Daly), a granddaughter, Mrs. George Brandis (1711) joined the famous "almond" family.

LONG-LIVERS. Those descendants who read these notes may well be cheered by the ancestral record of longevity. Few children of the Hyde descent died in infancy. In an age when the expectancy of life of those who survived the first two years of mortal career was barely fifty, the record of our pioneers is encouraging. Patriarch John and elder daughter Mary Anne reached the early fifties. Robert reached the middle sixties, Eleanor the seventies, James eighty-six, and the grand old lady, ninety-eight. Mary, widow of James, died ten years after her husband — not quite eighty-eight. At the time of compilation there are two of the family already in the nineties — not out!

JOHN JEREMIAH. (11). Of all the family John Jeremiah presents the most romantic figure. He was the eldest of the thirty-two grandchildren of the patriarchs — and the tallest. His height — six feet four inches, his ten gallon hat, his blue eyes AND his accompanying five feet two inch wife made him a sight for folk to notice! Well known on both Yorke and Eyre Peninsulas, J.J. spent time in the hotel business, but returned to the family following of farm life. He it was who laid the foundations of the Port Lincoln properties. J.J. had to wait until his wife turned twenty-one before they married. Little Rachel was a thorough matriarch herself; she ruled; nine children they had, and their seventy-five years of married life only ceased when J.J. died, aged ninety-five. Rachel followed him a year later. J.J. was known widely in the family and outside. They lost a son in World War I, and a most distinguished grand daughter in World War II. (She numbers 1111 in the table). Of J.J.'s children, two, the eldest and the youngest, remain; Mrs. McFarlane (111) bids to rival her parents in longevity. It is to be hoped that she will not mind reference to the mare's milk on which she thrived as a baby.

Three of J.J.'s sisters have established families — Symons, Daly and Clarke, two of which bid fair to outnumber those of the Hyde name. If there were any "title" attached to the name, the heir apparent would be Philip John Sinclair Hyde (115111) born only a dozen years after his great, great grandfather died.

MARY ANN. (2). This whole account of the families deriving from "Hyde of Hamilton" seeks to include all descendants. There are then over eighty several surnames, the most common being that of FORD. Mary Ann met John Ford on his return from an unsuccessful few months in the Victorian goldfields. He had joined a ship on the Clyde, and (history doesn't relate all details) arrived in Australia in early manhood. His farming began at One Tree Hill, and, later, in county Light, between Freeling and Kapunda, still known as "FORDS". Most of the large family were born near Kapunda. There is a story that a son named Samuel died, (he would have been born about 1858) but his name was given to a later one! This not being yet authenticated, is omitted in the numbering. It is known that the house on the rise just north of Kapunda, for many years of late occupied by the Hayward branch (361), was the family home in the "sixties". The Ford family moved to Yorke Peninsula, settling south of Robert and Eleanor Moody near Minlaton. The property name "Glenburnie" was carried by Robert Ford (24) to the Adelaide suburb of Torrens Park, where the house and the name "Ford" feature in the district. The country town of Beverley in the West well knows the name "Ford". Selby Ford (282) is famed for the aeroplane which he and a friend built. If flew!

The youngest of the family, A.E. (Herb) was only six when his mother died. Eleanor (Nell) was already married, James went to the Northern Territory (his father lost much in the tin boom). Others who "escaped" were Samuel (25) who became a banker, and Ernst (27) who went to Western Australia. Anne Jane kept house for twelve years. The eldest son, J.H. ("Jock") remained at Minlaton continuing the farming tradition and the name "John" to the fifth generation (21111). (The McFarlane branch has a similar "John" tradition, from 111 to 111211). Anne is buried at Minlaton. She was the first of the four children to die. When John Ford died in 1914, his executor was his youngest, A.E., then a senior officer of Adelaide's M.T.T. (Scottish accent is said to have been the cause of the mistake of "Albert" for "Herbert", the former already part of another son's name).

JAMES. (3). Aged seventeen when his father died, James worked with Robert for a dozen years, remaining a bachelor until his middle thirties. He married Mary Bradshaw, ten years younger than than he. They were, despite this long bachelorhood, the only couple of our five pioneer couples to celebrate their golden wedding. Of their five daughters, only two married, and their husbands were brothers. James's youngest daughter, Charlotte (36) still lives in Kapunda. She is probably the only living South Australian whose father came to the State in the first five years. James had one son, who was killed in an accident, two years after his father died. James the younger had two daughters, both now grandmothers. It seems, therefore, that the surname HYDE is, so far, carried on solely by the progeny of Kenneth John (115).

James the pioneer was a "character". He kept careful watch over his daughters. It is reported that he presented a cash cheque at his Kapunda bank. Clad is his farming clothes, looking to the new teller like a labourer, he was shocked when his cheque was referred for verification of his signature! He shouted, "Give me my b———money", and the manager needed some tact to pacify his irate customer.

ELEANOR. (4). The baby of the pioneers was thirteen years of age when her father died. Fifteen years later, after Robert had gone to Kilkerran, she followed him as the bride of Samuel Butler MOODY, the first of three of that name. They had eight children, but only one boy who was given his father's name. The present holder, S.B. Moody III (422) has two sons. Students of these tables will notice that Ruth Moody (44) married a man of that name. On Yorke Peninsula the S.B. family came from a property of the well-known name INNISFAIL. The other family is known as GORTMORE. There is probably a common origin of the two families. Charlotte (46) married her cousin Alexander Ford (27). It is understood that their one child died at birth or in early infancy.

Rodney Cockburn links the name of Hyde Park, originally "Hyde's Paddock", with the family. It would help if somewhere firm proof of this could be obtained. In the record, in Kapunda, of Robert Albert Ford's baptism in 1864, his home in that area is given as "Hyde Park". His father's property was understood to be named "INVERMAY". The original family property has for many years been known as "HYDEDALE". There are none of the family left in Hamilton now except Ian Hyde Murray (362).

The major names of the family may be sought in three areas. Hamilton-Kapunda, may well be considered the "home", especially as the last of the second generation lives there (36). The other places are Central Yorke Peninsula, and Port Lincoln.

GUIDE.

The family lists are set out twice. On the centre spread the whole "scheme" of the descendants is set out so that the inter-connections can be traced, and the generations kept together. Names of spouses and series numbers are the only details for which there is room. More detailed accounts are set out in the family groupings. In recognition of the position of the "pioneers" and their large families, they are listed as first and second generations. Eighteen of the second generation are listed as the founders of "families". The final page lists the surnames, with reference to number series. These numbers, planned like a catalogue, indicate the place in the "tree".
